POST-IT EXERCISE

Self-identification assessment

EQUIPMENT

Flipcharts x 5

Post-it notes – red x 60

Post-it notes – yellow x 60

Post-it notes – green x 60

Whiteboard x 1

Whiteboard markers x 3



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PURPOSE

This activity is designed to provide teachers with an idea of the level of expertise in each class by getting students to self-identify their level of expertise, if any, with each of the relevant social networks.

Set-up

The flipcharts should be set-up at different points in the room.

The instructions for the exercise should be written on the whiteboard with the colour-coding for post-its clearly highlighted.

Each flipchart should have a heading for a different social network or subject. The headings are:

- 1. LinkedIn
- 2. Facebook
- 3. Twitter
- 4. Google+
- 5. Meetup.com

Students will each be given 15 post-its (5 red, 5 yellow and 5 green)

Put a post-it note on each chart indicating level of familiarity with that social network:

red = never used
yellow = some familiarity
green = very familiar

ACTIVITY

Ask the students to think about each of the social networks or subjects shown. Then ask them to place a post-it note on each of the charts, indicating their level of familiarity with each social network as above.

Take a note of how many post-its of each colour appear on each chart and note using the chart on the back of this page.

Tailor explanations, speed of delivery of training based on the level of expertise indicated, ensuring that any students who are less familiar with the material receive any additional support necessary.
